Logic&FORM is pleased to announce that it has just achieved a total carbon offset of an extensive domestic alteration and addition of a property in Cammeray for R G Gregson Constructions, making the total renovation carbon neutral.

The project involves extensive demolition and alteration to the existing ground floor footprint and an extensive first floor addition.

The prime CO2 generation (27 tonnes) came from the demolition and disposal off waste as well as fuel, electrical and water usage over the duration off the construction.

The total carbon emission was offset by purchasing offset abatement certificates approved by the NSW Government.

The director of R G Gregson Constructions said:

“The response from the local community has been phenomenal and the local papers are keen to do an editorial on this carbon neutral project. Given that the offsets cost less than \$1900.00 for a project costing over half a million dollars, makes this investment both good for the environment and for marketing environmentally friendly products and services. We have received over 18 calls in the first week of our signage being displayed on the site”

R G Gregson Constructions and its prime contractors are also carbon friendly and certified environmentally in their own fields of expertise.
